



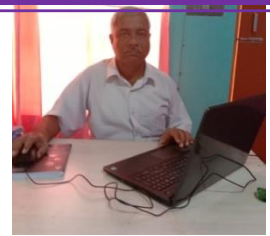
# SHIBGANJ INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY





## About organization

**Shibganj Integrated Development Society (SIDS)** is a community-based development organization established on **1 April 2005** in the Sundarbans region. It is registered under the **West Bengal Societies Registration Act**, the **FCRA Act**, and other relevant government and non-government regulatory frameworks. Governed by a statutory body, SIDS operates in full compliance with applicable laws and the guidelines of its donor partners.



The organization works for the development of needy and disadvantaged communities in the Sundarbans, focusing on key thematic areas such as education, health, environment, agriculture, digital technology, rights and entitlements, disability inclusion (PWDs), women's empowerment, and livelihood development.

Guided by the principles of good governance, transparency, and honesty, SIDS prioritizes the well-being of children, adolescents, students, women, youth, and the elderly, aiming to create sustainable and inclusive development across the region.

## Genesis of the organization:

Shibganj Integrated Development Society (SIDS) was established on 1 April 2005 in the remote islands of the Sundarbans. Its formation was inspired by a group of local youths who had witnessed the harsh realities of life in the region—premature deaths due to hunger, the suicide of an abused pregnant woman, and children from poor families being pushed into illegal activities driven by illiteracy and extreme poverty. These incidents deeply moved Mr. Subimal Karan, a young community leader and now Secretary of SIDS, who understood that true development was impossible without women's empowerment and social awareness. Under his leadership, the youths united to create an organization dedicated to education, gender justice, and economic upliftment. SIDS began its journey in two villages of Pathar Pratima block in South 24 Parganas, West Bengal.

## Vision:

The society will be free from poverty, deprivation and unjust. It will be a self-reliant society based on human values like Cooperation, participation, justice, respect and love where people will participate in the decentralized political process, where the economy will be based on localized production and consumption, the environment will be free from pollution and exploitation, the people will survive with their own indigenous socio-cultural identity.

## Education:

The organization has established a Pre-Primary and Primary school in coastal areas of Sundarbans since 2018. The children belong to fishermen families, agricultural families, working class families, unschooling hereditary families, and very poor families. The organization is trying to reach the goal of providing quality organization to children.



## Health:



Various projects implemented by the organization to provide health services to poor adolescents and mothers in coastal areas are Reproductive Child Health Care, Menstrual Health and Life Skills Education of adolescent girls, Community Health Development, Installation of Tube wells for safe drinking water, Construction of toilets, etc.

## Environment:

Our organization continues its efforts in environmental protection and conservation of biological diversity. It has implemented various types of programs in Sundarbans like a forestation, seminar and awareness camps, solid waste management, water resource management and Biotechnology oriented programs.



## Agriculture:



We believe that Agriculture is the basis of the village development. We have always prioritized agriculture among our goals. The program includes: Increasing sustainable farming practices among cultivators, supplying of agricultural minikits, organizing training programs, fruit plants distribution, and others programs.

### Natural Disaster:

One of SIDS's main objectives is to stand by flood victims and provide relief. The Sundarbans areas face natural calamities every year. The organization provided tarpaulins, dry ration, and cooked meal among the affected people of Bulbul, Amphan and Yaas.



### Women empowerment:



In all societies, power is not equally distributed. Economic and social empowerment puts women and girls in a stronger position. The women in Sundarban areas have no any ability as skilled worker for their livelihood without agriculture. The SIDS has been organizing various types of vocational and handicrafts trainings, awareness camps and seminars about legal rights, sexual violence, etc.

### Nutrition program



Shibganj Integrated Development Society (SIDS) organizes nutrition training programs for coastal poor women to improve their health and well-being. The sessions focus on balanced diets, use of locally available foods, and low-cost nutritious recipes. Women are educated on child and maternal nutrition, hygiene, and prevention of malnutrition. Practical demonstrations and interactive discussions make the training more effective. This initiative empowers coastal women to ensure food security and better health for their families.

### Helping elderly people



Shibganj Integrated Development Society (SIDS) organized a humanitarian distribution drive for coastal poor elderly people with no family support. Essential winter blankets were provided to protect them from the biting cold. Alongside, dry food items such as rice, musur dal, nutritious bodi, biscuits, and mustard oil were distributed. The initiative aimed to ensure warmth, nutrition, and dignity for vulnerable elders. Beneficiaries expressed deep gratitude for this timely support during the harsh season.
